

Privacy Policy

The Venture Capital Office Managers Association (VCOMA) takes the privacy of its members and other visitors to www.vcoma.com (the "website") very seriously. It is VCOMA's general policy to collect only information that our members and visitors knowingly provide. VCOMA reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy at any time. All changes will be posted on this web page.

Contact Information

VCOMA may request or require contact and other personal identifying information, such as your name, address, phone number, and email address. Your contact information may be used by VCOMA to provide its services, to create a personalized experience, and to get in touch with you when necessary with respect to transactions conducted through the website, new services VCOMA may offer, important membership information, material changes in our website's policies, and other purposes.

Opt-Out Privacy Statement

An important benefit of membership in VCOMA is our periodic email notices regarding special promotions and news. Because we take your privacy seriously, VCOMA has developed an online "opt-out" process for our email subscription program. The opt-out process meets the strictest anti-spam guidelines and is designed to protect your privacy by ensuring you only receive emails of interest to you. You may change your subscription selections and opt-in or out at any time through your member profile or by contacting us at remove@vcoma.com.

VCOMA never leases or sells your contact information to third parties. Rather, marketer information regarding special promotions and news that VCOMA deems of interest to our members is distributed on behalf of third parties through VCOMA. Again, you may opt-out of receiving these email notices by following the steps above.

Credit Card Account Information. VCOMA does not collect or store credit card account information provided by its members and customers. All online credit card payments are processed through PayPal's secure payment website.

Survey Information

The information we collect in online surveys is used for internal research purposes. In general, we do not divulge individual responses to surveys. The aggregate data from surveys may be shared with advertisers or other third parties, including our business partners, suppliers, and vendors, and we may publish survey data on our website. Member contact information will never be shared.

Demographic Information

Demographic and profile data (e.g., gender and income level) may also be collected at our website. This data will not be shared with advertisers or other third parties with the possible exception of our trusted corporate partners, although this is not currently common practice. We may also maintain a database of transactions on the website, and we may use this information in aggregate form to track the success of our website. Member contact information will never be shared.

Internet Protocol Address

We collect an IP address from all users of our website. We use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server, and to administer our website. We do not share your IP address with other third parties, except to a court or governmental agency if required by law. In addition, we do not rent, license, or sell IP addresses to any third party.

Use of Cookies

Our website may use cookies to enhance your experience while using our website. Cookies are pieces of information that some websites transfer to the computer that is browsing that website and are used for record-keeping purposes at many websites. Use of cookies makes web-surfing easier by performing certain functions such as saving your passwords, your personal preferences regarding your use of the particular website and to make sure you don't see the same ad repeatedly. Many consider the use of cookies to be an industry standard.

Your browser is probably set to accept cookies. However, if you would prefer not to receive cookies, you can alter the configuration of your browser to refuse cookies. If you choose to have your browser refuse cookies, it is possible that some areas of our website will not function properly when you view them.

Customization

Online purchases

If a user places an online order, their personal information will be used to fulfill the order, and may be shared with third parties involved in fulfilling your order (for example, a publisher).

Event registration

If a user registers for an event online, their personal information will be used to fulfill that request, and may be shared with third parties involved with the event (for example, an event planner).

Sponsored Event Drawings/Raffles

At times we may hold drawings and/or raffles at our events. The gifts are often donated by our sponsors and other third-party partners. If the event attendee volunteers their contact information to enter the drawing/raffle, it may be shared with the sponsor(s) of the event who donated the prize or sponsored the raffled item.
